Spotless frame and body, with exception to notes below, no rust. Minor cosmetic scratches in paint.

## **Known problems:**

1. Trunk has some corrosion (it is aluminum). Cosmetic only, does not leak.
2. Minor corrosion starting on body just aft of front wheels.
3. AdvanceTrac light comes on sometimes, more often when cold, saying "service advancetrac". No other issues noted, traction control and cruise control always work.
4. Air conditioning works great, however, there must be a valve for the heater stuck open because the drivers side will always blow hot air unless coolant hose is pinched off.
5. Drivers seat heat does not work. Passenger seat heat does work.

## **Why am I selling it?**

I own this car as well as a 2004 GMC Sierra. I've decided that it's not financially feasible to own and maintain two vehicles so I've decided to sell both and purchase a mid-sized SUV.

I bought this car with 114,000 miles on it and have never planned on selling it, the maintenance history reflects that. I have kept this car in immaculate condition and I have spared no expense maintaining and upgrading it. This is a really powerful fun car to drive with a classic smooth Lincoln ride.
